



The purpose of this letter is to respectfully request to be placed on the Board's calendar for Public Convenience and Necessity approval regarding a Type 20 alcoholic beverage license that we have applied for at 340 Balboa Street. Tofino Wines Inc intends to open as a neighborhood wine merchant, combining our deep knowledge of wine and hospitality, to create a curated selection of wines that will serve the residents of the Richmond District and the whole of San Francisco. Our wine selections cannot be found in grocery stores, discount retailers or other big box stores; and we will provide friendly service backed by years of wine and retail expertise, whether we are engaging neighborhood locals, wine connoisseurs or other industry professionals.

Our business proves to be necessary in San Francisco, as there is a passion for small wine producers and wines made in natural way, but there is not an appropriate retail establishment to serve the needs of consumers with a great selection of wines, excellent customer service and education. Our operations will be a solution to this by offering attentive service to guests whether they are shopping for a \$24 bottle or a \$120 bottle. Our goal has always been to build long lasting relationships in the community and to provide a robust calendar of winemaker tasting and educational opportunities to learn about wine regions, grape varieties, and other timely topics in the wine industry, such as the impacts of the climate crisis on wine regions in California and abroad. While most of our tasting and educational classes will be open to the adult public, and we will offer small group tastings as well.

Tofino Wines Inc is a SF-based, family-owned company that operated a popular wine bar and wine retail shop called Tofino Wines at Geary and Masonic from April 2015 to April 2024. We have hundreds of local customers, many of whom live near 340 Balboa. Tofino Wines has received recognition as being one of San Francisco's best wine shops (from Esther Mobley, Senior Wine Critic, SF Chronicle, May 2024) and for specializing in and discovering new and exciting wines to introduce to customers. Some of our best customers were young winemakers working in Napa or Sonoma, or people studying wine in sommelier classes or a tasting group of their peers. These customers knew that we had wine they could not find anywhere else in Northern California.

We closed our business on Geary Blvd in April 2024 and plan to open a retail-only wine business at 340 Balboa that will build on both our existing customer relationships and experience in serving the community. It was very important for us, when looking for a new
