

1 [Appointment]

2 APPOINTING AMY WAH MAN YU, TERM ENDING AUGUST 20, 2001, TO THE LEAD  
3 POISONING PREVENTION CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE, WAIVING RESIDENCY  
4 REQUIREMENT.

5  
6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
7 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated person to serve as member of the Lead  
8 Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the San  
9 Francisco Health Code, Section 1607, for the term specified:

10  
11 Amy Wah Man Yu, succeeding Loretta Krueger, (Seat No. 17, must have expertise in  
12 immigrant services), for the unexpired portion of a 4-year term ending August 20, 2001.

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 15 1. The membership of the Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee  
16 has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San  
17 Francisco.
- 18 2. Applicant Amy Wah Man Yu, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San  
19 Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on  
20 the Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee.
- 21 3. The Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee has attempted to fill  
22 the position, for which Amy Wah Man Yu was nominated, with an individual who is  
23 a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but  
24 has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Amy

1 Wah Man Yu is qualified to serve on the Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens  
2 Advisory Committee.

- 3 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no  
4 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the  
5 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is  
6 willing to serve on the Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee at  
7 this time; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency  
9 requirement for Amy Wah Man Yu, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident,  
10 willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires  
11 person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative  
12 act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.




