14 WHEREAS, Our San Francisco team of 9-1-1 dispatchers and support staff is
15 comprised of approximately 250 personnel; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors recognizes the hard work and dedication of our
17 public safety professionals every day of the year as they handle the community’s calls for help
18 and declares April 11, 2004 through April 17, 2004 as “Public Safety Telecommunicators
