

1 [Mechanical Code.]

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3 **Resolution endorsing those changes and providing findings as to the local conditions**  
4 **requiring amendments to the State Mechanical Code, as required by California Health**  
5 **and Safety Code.**

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7 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is enacting a Mechanical Code for the City and  
8 County of San Francisco to be known as the "2001 San Francisco Mechanical Code"; and

9 WHEREAS, The aforesaid San Francisco Mechanical Code differs in part from the  
10 State Mechanical Code for buildings; and

11 WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Section 17958.5 requires the City to  
12 furnish to the California Building Standards Commission reasons for amending the State  
13 Mechanical code based upon local conditions; and,

14 WHEREAS, A specific section by section statement of the reasons for each  
15 amendment is set forth in that certain document in the Board of Supervisor's file No. \_\_\_\_  
16 \_\_\_\_\_ identified therein and hereinafter referred to as Exhibit A; and

17 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has reviewed the statement of reasons set forth  
18 for each amendment in said Exhibit A; and

19 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that these differences in  
20 the San Francisco Mechanical Code are necessary because of local conditions for the  
21 reasons set forth in Exhibit A; now therefore be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby find and determine that  
23 the aforesaid changes to the San Francisco Mechanical Code are necessary because of local  
24 conditions for the reasons set forth in Exhibit A; and be it

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1                   FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is hereby  
2 directed to transmit this Resolution together with the San Francisco Mechanical Code to the  
3 California Building Standards Commission for filing, pursuant to the applicable provisions of  
4 law.

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
