Hearing to consider that the issuance of a Type-57 special on-sale general beer, wine, and distilled spirits liquor license to MG-SC, LLC, doing business as Shack15, located at One Ferry Building, Suite 201 (District 3), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San Francisco. 01/13/20; RESPONSE RECEIVED. The Planning Department submitted their recommendation for approval; Restaurant (dba Shack15) is principally permitted and allowed as an accessory use in the C-2/waterfront Zoning District per Planning Code, Sections 210.1 and 240.

01/16/20; RESPONSE RECEIVED. The Police Department submitted a response recommending approval with the following conditions:

- 1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight) each day of the week; and
- 2) Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on the most recently certified ABC-253.

01/23/20; CONTINUED. Heard in Committee. Speakers: Officer Pat Macchi (Police Department); Beth Aboulafia (Hinman and Carmichael, LLP); presented information and answered questions raised throughout the discussion.

Heard in Committee. Speakers: Soraya Fouladi (Jara Worldwide); Speaker; Ben Davis (Illuminate); Catie van Dyke (Shack15); spoke in support of the hearing matter.

A determination that the public convenience or necessity would be served was recommended by the committee.

Chair Mandelman moved that this Hearing be PREPARED IN COMMITTEE AS A RESOLUTION, making a determination that the issuance of a Type-57 special on-sale general beer, wine, and distilled spirits liquor license to the applicant will serve the public convenience or necessity.
