Section 1. Background.

The Office of the Mayor has applied for and has been awarded a grant from Bloomberg Philanthropies, in the amount of \$7,000,000 to cover the period from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2028, to expand the Mayor's Office of Innovation. Bloomberg Philanthropies is supporting the City and County of San Francisco, California in building a next-generation innovation team (the Mayor's Office of Innovation) that will serve as a catalyst for designing

and scaling solutions to the City's most pressing challenges and offer a model and learnings
to other local governments tackling similar challenges. The Mayor's Office of Innovation will
deliver for San Franciscans by leading critical projects that support the Mayor's top priorities,
such as clean, safe streets and economic revitalization. The Mayor's Office of Innovation will
bring valuable skillsets that are rarer in the City workforce, such as product management and
user centered design, to accelerate progress on these priorities.

Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Grant Funds; Approval of Grant Agreement.

- (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Mayor's Office to accept and expend \$7,000,000 in grant funds from Bloomberg Philanthropies to expand the Mayor's Office of Innovation, which will use data, digital tools, human-centered design, public-private partnerships, and other innovative approaches to deliver outcomes and advance government accountability and transparency for San Francisco residents, as generally set forth in the grant application and grant budget and Grant Agreement, all of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____ and which are incorporated herein by reference. The Mayor's Office of Innovation proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget, and indirect costs are hereby waived. The grant requires the City to partially match the grant funds, either through additional general fund sources or philanthropic fundraising, equal to at least \$2,333,333, with one half secured by September 30, 2026 and the balance by September 30, 2027.
- (b) The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Grant Agreement pursuant to Charter Section 9.118.
