WHEREAS, San Francisco State University currently offers 115 undergraduate degrees, 93 master's degrees, and two joint doctorates in 83 academic departments with a faculty that includes world-famous astronomers, a Pulitzer Prize winner, and the recipient of the MacArthur Foundation genius grant; and,

WHEREAS, Among San Francisco State University's graduates are members of Congress, mayors, successful entrepreneurs, established actors, doctors, lawyers, and other professionals; and,

WHEREAS, San Francisco State University has been praised by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges' reaccreditation team as "a campus committed to multiculturalism and to opportunity for a wide range of students;" and,

WHEREAS, On March 22, 1999, San Francisco State University begins a year-long celebration of its centennial anniversary; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco celebrates the 100th anniversary of San Francisco State University and recognizes its academic, creative, and cultural contributions to the San Francisco Bay Area.
