5 WHEREAS, San Francisco State Normal School was established by the California
6 State Legislature in 1899 as a school for teachers and was one of the first in the country to
7 require a high school diploma; and,

8 WHEREAS, In 1921, the San Francisco State Normal School began offering a
9 bachelor's degree option and by the 1950s, San Francisco State University attracted national
10 attention for its General Education program; and,

11 WHEREAS, San Francisco State University currently offers 115 undergraduate
12 degrees, 93 master's degrees, and two joint doctorates in 83 academic departments with a
13 faculty that includes world-famous astronomers, a Pulitzer Prize winner, and the recipient of
14 the MacArthur Foundation genius grant; and,

15 WHEREAS, Among San Francisco State University's graduates are members of
16 Congress, mayors, successful entrepreneurs, established actors, doctors, lawyers, and other
17 professionals; and,

18 WHEREAS, San Francisco State University has been praised by the Western
19 Association of Schools and Colleges' reaccreditation team as "a campus committed to
20 multiculturalism and to opportunity for a wide range of students;" and,

21 WHEREAS, On March 22, 1999, San Francisco State University begins a year-long
22 celebration of its centennial anniversary; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
24 celebrates the 100th anniversary of San Francisco State University and recognizes its
25 academic, creative, and cultural contributions to the San Francisco Bay Area.
