WHEREAS, The 2011 Public Safety Realignment Act, Assembly Bills 109 and 117 ("AB109/117") were signed into law by Governor Edmund G. Brown on April 4, 2011, and June 30, 2011, respectively, and took effect on October 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, California Penal Code Section 1230.1(a) as added and amended by AB109/117 requires each County's Community Corrections Partnership to recommend a local plan to the County Board of Supervisors for the implementation of the 2011 Public Safety Realignment Act; and

WHEREAS, Section 1230.1(b) further requires that an Executive Committee of the Community Corrections Partnership be formed to prepare and approve presentation of the plan to the Board of Supervisors, and that the Executive Committee be consisted of the Chief Probation Officer, the Chief of Police, the Sheriff, the District Attorney, the Public Defender, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court or the Court's Designee, and the Head of the Agency in charge of social services, mental health, or alcohol and substance abuse programs, as designated by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to 1230.1(c) the plan shall be deemed accepted by the County Board of Supervisors unless rejected by a vote of 4/5th, in which case the plan goes back to the Community Corrections Partnership for further consideration; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2011, the Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted resolution File No. 110732, appointing the Department of Public Health to the Executive Committee of the San Francisco Community Corrections Partnership for the purpose of developing an

implementation plan for criminal justice realignment; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2011, the Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted resolution File No. 110920, approving the City and County of San Francisco 2011 Public Safety Realignment Plan; and

WHEREAS, since October 1, 2011, the Community Corrections Partnership Executive Committee, chaired by Chief Adult Probation Officer Wendy Still, has successfully implemented the City and County of San Francisco 2011 Public Safety Realignment Plan; and

WHEREAS, a broad-based and inclusive community input process was conducted in order to inform revised strategies and recommendations of the "City & County of San Francisco Public Safety Realignment & Post-Release Community Supervision 2012 Implementation Plan"; and

WHEREAS, at meeting of June 1, 2012, the Community Corrections Partnership

Executive Committee presented and approved the "City & County of San Francisco Public

Safety Realignment & Post-Release Community Supervision 2012 Implementation Plan"; and
