to continue a certain project designated "Operation Revitalization-Ocean View/Merced
Heights/Ingleside" (herein after referred to as "Operation Revitalization-OMI") funded
from funds made available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning
(herein after referred to as OCJP) for the suppression, intervention, and prevention of
crime in the Ocean View/Merced Heights/Ingleside District; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San Francisco is
authorized on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco to accept and expend
continued funding for this project from OCJP, and waiving indirect costs due to funding
constraints; and be it




FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City and County of San

The State of California and OCJP disclaim responsibility for and such liability; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby waive indirect costs, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.




