

1 [Abolishing a portion of official sidewalk]

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3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled “Regulating the Width of Sidewalks”**  
4 **by adding thereto Section No. 1559 to abolish a portion of official sidewalk on the**  
5 **westerly side of Lyon Street south of Bay Street; making findings pursuant to the**  
6 **General Plan and Planning Code Section 101.1; and requiring relocation, modification,**  
7 **or both of facilities affected by the sidewalk abolishment.**

12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference  
14 herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning Department in its letter  
15 dated December 12, 2002, which stated that this project is in conformity with the San  
16 Francisco General Plan. A copy of such letter is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File  
17 No. 030541.

18 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works’ Order No. 173,907, a  
19 copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 030541, Board of  
20 Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled “Regulating the Width of Sidewalks,” a copy of  
21 which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May  
22 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

23 Section 1559. A portion of official sidewalk on the westerly side of Lyon Street south of Bay  
24 Street shall be abolished as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-553, a copy of which  
25 is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 030541.

1 Section 3. The Presidio Trust, as is necessary as a result of this Ordinance, shall  
2 make arrangements with public utility companies and City departments for the relocation  
3 and/or adjustment of existing utility facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas. Any  
4 necessary relocation, modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and  
5 County of San Francisco.
