Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Planning Department to apply for a planning grant from the State of California Sustainable Communities Planning Grant and Incentives Program under the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84) to complete an Urban Forest Master Plan.

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the program shown above; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Growth Council has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the Strategic Growth Council require a resolution certifying the approval by the City’s governing board before submission of said application to the State; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department, in coordination with the Department of Public Works and the Department of the Environment, if selected, will enter into an agreement with the Sate of California to carry out the development of an Urban Forest Master Plan in the amount of \$250,000;

1 WHEREAS, the proposed Urban Forest Master Plan will develop policy
 2 recommendations and implementation strategies for the pro-active management of the City’s
 3 Urban Forest; now, therefore, be it

 5 RESOLVED, that the Director of the Planning Department, or a designee, is hereby
 6 authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City and County of San Francisco
 7 all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments hereto
 8 for the purpose of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified
 9 in the grant application; and, be it

 11 FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco authorizes the
 12 submittal of additional grant applications by the Planning Department to the Strategic Growth
 13 Council for all available grants and this resolution shall remain in effect for five (5) years.
