9	WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code, Section 381 requires electrical		
10	companies to collect a surcharge on all retail sales, called "the Public Goods Charge," and		
11	turn that money over to the California Public Utilities Commission ("the CPUC"); and		
12	WHEREAS, Section 381 authorizes the CPUC to allocate that money to fund programs		
13	that enhance system reliability and provide in-state benefits, including cost-effective energy		
14	efficiency, renewable energy technologies, and public interest research; and		
15	WHEREAS, The City, through the Department of the Environment, and the Pacific Gas		
16	and Electric Company ("PG&E") have, since 2003, entered into a series of contracts and		
17	contract modifications to conduct energy efficiency programs in the City using Public Goods		
18	Charge funds allocated for this purpose by the CPUC through PG&E and		
19	WHEREAS, The CPUC, at its meeting of October 16, 2014, made an award of		
20	\$300,000,000 of Public Goods Charge revenues to PG&E to fund energy efficiency programs;		
21	and		
22	WHEREAS, PG& E has declared its intention to fund program activities for the		
23	calendar year 2015 in the amount of \$6,659,949; and		
24	WHEREAS, The Department of the Environment has negotiated a new revenue		
25	contract with PG&E ("the Contract"); and		

1	WHEREAS, In Resolution No. 481-09, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Directo		
2	of the Department of the Environment pursuant to Charter Section 9.118 to enter into the		
3	Contract; and		
4	WHEREAS, The grant does	not require an Annual Salary Ordinance (ASO)	
5	amendment and partially reimburses the Department of the Environment for 12 existing		
6	positions; and		
7	WHEREAS, The term of this grant is from January 1, 2015, to December 31, 2015; and		
8	WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because the Departmetr		
9	of the Environment needed time to	determine the budgetary allocations for the grant; and	
10	WHEREAS, The budget incl	udes indirect costs of \$689,476; now, therefore, be it	
11	RESOLVED, That pursuant	to Administrative Code, Section 10.170-1, the Board of	
12	Supervisors authorizes the Departn	nent of the Environment to retroactively accept and expend	
13	a grant in the amount of up to \$6,659,949 from California Public Utilities Commission, through		
14	the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, to effectuate the Contract and implement an Energy		
15	Use and Demand Reduction Through Energy Efficiency Program in the City and County of		
16	San Francisco.
