WHEREAS, The Stanford Geriatric Education Center is the recipient of a grant award from the Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) to support geriatric education centers; and,

WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of HRSA, Stanford and DPH to participate in this project; and,

WHEREAS, Stanford has agreed to fund DPH-LHH for the transitional healthcare project in the amount of \$10,000 under the terms of this agreement for the period of September 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008, with two additional years (through August 31, 2010) if funds are available and satisfactory progress is made; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds Stanford requires DPH to enter into a subaward agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _______, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses the DPH-LHH for five existing positions, including three Clinical Nurse Specialists (Job Class #2323) at .023 FTE, .001 FTE and .001 FTE, one Manager VII (Job Class #0943) at .008 FTE, one Health Worker III (Job Class #2587) at .026 FTE for the period of September 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008; and,
