3 **Motion for the Board of Supervisors to convene in closed session to consult with the**
4 **Mayor and City's Labor Relations Negotiators for the purpose of reviewing the City's**
5 **positions and the Mayor's instructions to the Negotiators relating to: (a) pension,**
6 **health care, and retiree health care reform proposals, and the meet and confer process**
7 **regarding wages, hours, benefits, and working conditions currently underway between**
8 **the City and City employee bargaining units to address the costs associated with**
9 **providing these benefits; and (b) pending labor negotiations with organizations**
10 **representing employees in the two MOUs expiring June 30, 2011 (e.g., District Attorney**
11 **Investigators Association and Committee on Interns and Residents), as well as the**
12 **Unrepresented Ordinance.**

14 WHEREAS, This closed session is permitted by Government Code Section 54957.6
15 and San Francisco Administrative Code Section 67.10(e); now, therefore, be it

16 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors convene in closed session to consult with the
17 Mayor and City's Labor Relations Negotiators for the purpose of reviewing the City's positions
18 and the Mayor's instructions to the Negotiators relating to: (a) pension, health care, and
19 retiree health care reform proposals, and the meet and confer process regarding wages,
20 hours, benefits, and working conditions currently underway between the City and City
21 employee bargaining units, listed below, to address the costs associated with providing these
22 benefits; and (b) pending labor negotiations with organizations representing employees in the
23 two MOUs expiring June 30, 2011 (e.g., District Attorney Investigators Association and
24 Committee on Interns and Residents), as well as the Unrepresented Ordinance.
