3	Resolution designating the Examiner to be the official newspaper of the City and County of
4	San Francisco for the category of Type 2 non-consecutive day official advertising, from
5	July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

8	WHEREAS, in each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the official newspaper of the
9	City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to Article IX, Section 2.80-1 and 2.81 of the San Francisco
10	Administrative Code; now therefore, be it
11	RESOLVED, that the <i>Examiner</i> , a newspaper of general circulation published in the City and
12	County of San Francisco for the dissemination of local or telegraphic news and intelligence of a general
13	character, having a bona fide circulation of at least 50,000 copies per calendar week, printed in the City
14	and County on three or more days in a calendar week, is hereby designated as an official newspaper of
15	the City and County of San Francisco, commencing July 1, 2007 for the publication of all official
16	advertising of the City and County which is required by law to be published one time, other than
17	advertising required by Section 2.103 of the Charter for special meetings of the Board of Supervisors
18	and its special or standing committees, and all official advertising of the City and County which is
19	required by law to be published more than one, but not more than three times per week for a specified
20	number of weeks, and, be it
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Office of Contract Administration is hereby authorized to
22	execute a contract with the Examiner and said contract must be in accordance with all the contracting
23	requirements of the City and County of San Francisco.
