Resolution urging the governor and state legislature of California to direct state agencies and departments to implement a program to reduce carbon dioxide emissions, in recognition of the tremendous environmental, economic, and public health threats posed by global warming.

WHEREAS, The United Nations' Intergovernmental Panel on Climate
Change has determined that by 2100, global warming will increase global mean
surface temperatures from three to eleven degrees fahrenheit, raise sea levels
by as many as three feet, cause the retreat of glaciers worldwide, increase storm
severity and weather extremes, and accelerate incidents of El Nino and resulting
droughts and floods; and

WHEREAS, Global warming is projected to have severe economic consequences to California and the nation's agriculture, fishing, construction, insurance, timber, trucking, transportation, tourism, and skiing industries, as well as to coastal communities; and

WHEREAS, Global warming is projected to increase smog in federal and state ozone non-attainment areas, increasing hospitalizations and health care costs to California; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges the governor and state legislature of California to determine a timeline for all state agencies and departments to implement reductions of CO₂ emissions that includes a set of target CO₂ emissions levels; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges the governor of California to issue an Executive Order stating specific goals for reducing CO₂ emissions for all state agencies and departments in any current and future regulatory actions; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges the California state legislature to sponsor and support legislation that will set specific goals for reducing CO₂ emissions in California, and to require all state agencies and departments to immediately adopt regulations to reduce CO₂ emissions; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall send a copy of this resolution to the governor of the state of California and members of the California state legislature.
