3 **Resolution urging the Department of Parking and Traffic to install STOP signs at the**
4 **intersection of Dolores and 19th Streets.**

6 WHEREAS, Dolores Street is a highly traveled corridor carrying significant traffic
7 between the Castro/Upper Market neighborhood, Noe Valley, and the Outer Mission, and is
8 also a highly utilized route to the Interstate 280 highway; and,

9 WHEREAS, the West side of the intersection of 19th and Dolores Streets constitutes a
10 major pedestrian entrance to Dolores Park, with significant pedestrian traffic crossing Dolores
11 Street; and,

12 WHEREAS, A steep grade on Dolores between 19th and 22nd Streets increases
13 speeding on Dolores Street in the Northbound direction through the intersection of Dolores
14 and 19th Streets; and,

15 WHEREAS, Area residents have noted frequent near-collisions between cars and both
16 pedestrians and dogs in the intersection of Dolores and 19th Streets; now, therefore, be it

17 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Parking and
18 Traffic to install STOP signs at the intersection of Dolores and 19th Streets.
