6	WHEREAS, Dolores Street is a highly traveled corridor carrying significant traffic
7	between the Castro/Upper Market neighborhood, Noe Valley, and the Outer Mission, and is
8	also a highly utilized route to the Interstate 280 highway; and,
9	WHEREAS, the West side of the intersection of 19th and Dolores Streets constitutes a
10	major pedestrian entrance to Dolores Park, with significant pedestrian traffic crossing Dolores
11	Street; and,
12	WHEREAS, A steep grade on Dolores between 19 <sup>th</sup> and 22 <sup>nd</sup> Streets increases
13 14	speeding on Dolores Street in the Northbound direction through the intersection of Dolores
15	and 19 <sup>th</sup> Streets; and,
16	WHEREAS, Area residents have noted frequent near-collisions between cars and both
17	pedestrians and dogs in the intersection of Dolores and 19 <sup>th</sup> Streets; now, therefore, be it
18	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Parking and
19	affic to install STOP signs at the intersection of Dolores and 19th Streets.
