1 [Provide medical services for prison inmates referred from institutions of the California 2 Department of Corrections. 3 Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, Community 4 Health Network of San Francisco (CHNSF), to enter retroactively into an agreement, 5 which includes an indemnification clause, with The State of California, Department of 6 Corrections (CDC), and accept reimbursement in the amount of \$225,000 for medical 7 services provided to inmates referred from the Correctional Training Facility (CTF) and 8 the California Medical Facility (CMF); for the period of March 1, 2002, to June 30, 2003. 9 10 WHEREAS, CHNSF shall render medical services to inmates as requested by the 11 CDC; and, 12 WHEREAS, The scope of services under this agreement includes, but is not limited to, 13 bed and board; medical, nursing, surgical, intensive care, pharmaceutical, dietary, basic 14 medical supplies, basic diagnostics such as general laboratory and x-rays, and related 15 services; and, 16 WHEREAS, CDC has agreed to reimburse CHNSF in an amount up to \$225,000 for 17 inmate health services for the term of this contract; and, 18 WHEREAS, CDC will reimburse CHNSF for these services at a rate of 8% (eight 19 percent) less than the SFGH charge master; and, 20 WHEREAS, As a condition of paying the funds CDC requires CHNSF to enter into a 21 Contract (The "Agreement") a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of 22 Supervisors in File No._____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this 23 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and, 24

1	WHEREAS, A mutual indemnification clause in the agreement states that CHNSF	
2	officials and employees shall be responsible for their own acts and omissions and CDC	
3	officers and employees shall be responsible for their own acts and omissions; and,	
4	WHEREAS, The terms of this agreement prohibit including indirect costs as a billable	
5	expense; now, therefore, be it	
6	RESOLVED, That CHNSF is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a contract,	
7	which includes an indemnification clause, to provide medical services to prison inmates and	
8	accept reimbursement in an amount up to \$225,000 from the CDC for services provided under	
9	the agreement; and, be it	
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of	
11	indirect costs in the budget of the agreement; and, be it	
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the	
13	agreement on behalf of the City.
