11 between life and death for the persons in need; and,

12 WHEREAS, Our nation’s 9-1-1 dispatchers are among the more than 500,000 public  
13 safety professionals who work daily to protect and promote the public safety; and,

14 WHEREAS, Our San Francisco teams of 9-1-1 dispatchers and support staff is  
15 comprised of about 250 personnel; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, The Board of Supervisors recognizes the hard work and dedication of our  
17 public safety professionals every day of the year as they handle the community’s calls for help  
18 and declares April 10, 2005 through April 16, 2005 as “Public Safety Telecommunications  
19 Week” in the City and County of San Francisco.
