

1 [Declaration of Election Results.]

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3 **Resolution declaring the results of the November 2, 2004 Consolidated General**
4 **Election.**

5 WHEREAS, A Consolidated General Election was conducted in the City and County of
6 San Francisco on Tuesday, November 2, 2004, which placed before the electorate candidates
7 for election to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors, the Governing Board of the
8 Community College District, and the Governing Board of the San Francisco Unified School
9 District, and fifteen City and County ballot measures; and,

10 WHEREAS, John Arntz, the Director of Elections of the City and County of San
11 Francisco, has certified to this Board of Supervisors the results of the Consolidated General
12 Election, a copy of which is contained in File 041646 of the Board of Supervisors, and which is
