[Urging the restoration of cuts to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development]

Resolution urging the United States Congress to restore cuts in the budget of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

WHEREAS, San Francisco is among the top ten cities to lose money under a new Housing and Urban Development (HUD) formula for distributing public housing operating funds: and

WHEREAS, HUD has issued guidance that would allow cities that are net losers under the new formula for operating subsidies to reduce their loses to 5% if they convert to a new budgeting system known as "asset management" by April 2007; and

WHEREAS, In June 2006, HUD notified public housing authorities that they will receive a pro-rated amount of 85.5% of their need for operating costs in 2006, due to the increased utility cost; and

WHEREAS, Congress will only appropriate 78% of the 2007 operating subsidy for public housing authorities; and

WHEREAS, The results of the cuts could result in a \$4 million FY 2007 operating budget shortfall for the San Francisco Housing Authority; and

WHEREAS, This inadequate funding level would seriously harm our ability to provide basic services such as security and increase our backlog of repairs to elevators and other vital services to our 6000 public housing residents; now, therefore, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges increased funding in the FY 2007 TTHUD Appropriations bill's Public Housing Operating Fund to cover the increased cost of utilities in 2006.
