

1 [Adding Board Rule 5.9 to Establish a Joint City and City College of San Francisco Select  
2 Committee]

4 **Motion amending the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors to add Rule 5.9, which**  
5 **establishes a Joint City and City College of San Francisco Select Committee.**

7 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco wish to  
8 establish a Joint City and City College of San Francisco Select Committee to hold hearings  
9 concerning issues of mutual interest that affect the City and the City College of San Francisco,  
10 its employees, its students, and the families of its students, including the issue of the on-going  
11 financial sustainability of the City College of San Francisco; and

12 WHEREAS, The membership of said Committee shall be comprised of three Members  
13 of the Board of Supervisors, appointed by the President of the Board of Supervisors, and  
14 three Members appointed by the Board of Trustees of the City College of San Francisco,  
15 which may include an enrolled City College student; and

16 WHEREAS, The meeting schedule of said Committee shall be established by the  
17 President of the Board of Supervisors, in conjunction with the Members of the Committee and  
18 Board of Trustees of the City College of San Francisco; and

19 WHEREAS, A Memorandum of Understanding, which details the specific  
20 responsibilities of the City and City College of San Francisco for said Committee, is on file  
21 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 110523, which is hereby declared to be  
22 a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

23 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
24 hereby amends its Rules of Order to add rule 5.9 to read as follows:

1            **5.9 Joint City and City College of San Francisco Select Committee.** *The Joint City and City*  
2 *College of San Francisco Select Committee shall be referred measures concerning issues of mutual*  
3 *interest that affect the City and the City College of San Francisco, its employees, its students, and the*  
4 *families of its students, including the issue of the on-going financial sustainability of the City College of*  
5 *San Francisco, and shall terminate one year from the date of the appointment of its members.*
