

16	(a)	When Administrative Code Chapter 109 was enacted, certain approvals and
17	permits by C	City departments and agencies were required for affordable housing projects.
18	Administrativ	ve Code Chapter 109 was enacted to prioritize the approvals and permits for
19	affordable h	ousing, and for the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development
20	("MOHCD")	to submit quarterly reports on the status of such approvals and permits.
21	MOHCD's q	uarterly reports assisted with identifying City departments and agencies that were
22	reviewing af	fordable housing projects and had pending approvals.
23	(b)	Since the enactment of Administrative Code Chapter 109, state law has been
24	changed to i	require a streamlined permit process for affordable housing through ministerial
25	approvals by	Y City departments and agencies, the City has established a central Permit Center

1	available to the public to track the status of permits online, and a Director of Housing Delivery
2	has been appointed to help facilitate the approval of housing in the City. In light of these
3	developments, a more limited set of information on housing approvals in MOHCD's reports is
4	now needed, and the reports need not be as frequent as before.
5	
6	Section 2. Chapter 109 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising
7	Section 109.3, to read as follows:
8	
9	SEC. 109.3. <i>QUARTERLY</i> REPORTS.
10	(a) <u>Quarterly Reports</u> . Beginning on December 15, 2018, the Mayor's Office of Housing
11	and Community Development ("MOHCD") shall provide a report to the Board of Supervisors
12	and <i>the</i> Mayor about the status of 100% Affordable Housing Projects pending before the
13	Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, Mayor's Office on
14	Disability, and Planning Department, and shall provide subsequent reports every three
15	months thereafter with the final quarterly report due December 15, 2024. The Department of
16	Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, Mayor's Office on Disability, and Planning
17	Department shall provide MOHCDthe Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development with
18	the information necessary to compile these reports. Each <i><u>quarterly</u></i> report, <u>atas</u> a minimum,
19	shall provide:
20	(<u>1</u> a) a list of every 100% Affordable Housing Project that has applied for
21	approval, permit, or other City authorization from the Department of Building Inspection,
22	Public Works, Fire Department, Mayor's Office on Disability, or Planning Department;

5	(b) Semi-Annual Reports. Beginning on July 31, 2025, and every six months thereafter,
6	MOHCD shall provide a report to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor about the status of 100%
7	<u>Affordable Housing Projects under development and/or construction with funding from MOHCD. The</u>
8	Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, and Planning Department shall
9	provide MOHCD with the information necessary to compile these semi-annual reports. Each report, at
10	<u>a minimum, shall provide:</u>
11	(1) a list of every 100% Affordable Housing Project that has applied for approval,
12	permit, or other City authorization from the Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire
13	Department, and/or Planning Department; and
14	(2) information regarding the financing and financing-related deadlines for each 100%
15	Affordable Housing Project.

17	Section 3. Effective Date; Retroactivity.
18	(a) This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs
19	when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not
20	sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the
21	Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
22	(b) In the event the effective date of this ordinance is later than March 14, 2025, then,
23	upon its effective date, the ordinance shall be retroactive to March 14, 2025.

[Administrative Code - Reports on 100% Affordable Housing by Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to end certain quarterly reporting requirements by the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development to the Board of Supervisors and Mayor regarding the development of 100% Affordable Housing, and to establish new semi-annual reporting requirements beginning on July 31, 2025.

Existing Law

Chapter 109 of the Administrative Code requires the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD") to provide the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor a quarterly report on the following: (1) 100% affordable housing projects that have applied for approval or a permit from the Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, Mayor's Office on Disability, and Planning Department, (2) information on the financing and financing deadlines for 100% affordable housing projects, (3) approvals or permits that are pending for each 100% affordable housing project, and (4) the dates of application for an approval or permit and the status of pending approvals and permits.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would amend MOHCD's reporting requirement to the following: (1) 100% affordable housing projects funded by MOHCD that have applied for approval, permit, or other City authorization from the Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, and/or Planning Department, and (2) information on the financing and financing deadlines for 100% affordable housing projects funded by MOHCD. The proposed ordinance would require MOHCD to submit a report every 6 months commencing on July 31, 2025. The last quarterly report would be due December 15, 2024.
