WHEREAS, San Francisco has the fourth highest rate of pedestrian fatalities in the United States for cities with more than 500,000 people; and

WHEREAS, District 11 and the Excelsior neighborhood is home to a high number of seniors and families with children; and,

WHEREAS, More than 550 people have been hurt by collisions with cars in the Excelsior in the past twelve years; and,

WHEREAS, The Excelsior Street Safe program has been working with neighborhood residents, holding community meetings and has conducted 550 surveys in English, Chinese and Spanish; and

WHEREAS, The Excelsior Street Safe program has developed a report based on survey results and other research, the "Community Action Plan for Safer Streets in the Excelsior," which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. , which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The cooperation of Department of Parking and Traffic, San Francisco Police Department and other city agencies is essential to the implementation of policies and programs which will make the Excelsior safer for pedestrians; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby urges Department of Parking and Traffic, the San Francisco Police Department, and

all other relevant city agencies to review the "Community Action Plan for Safer Streets in the Excelsior" and work with the Excelsior Street Safe project and community residents to implement the Plan's recommendations and any other measures which would improve pedestrian safety in the Excelsior.
