

1 [AIRPORT ADMINISTRATION]  
2 APPROVING THE CONTROLLER'S CERTIFICATION THAT AIRPORT  
3 INFORMATION BOOTH SERVICES AT SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL  
4 AIRPORT CAN BE PRACTICALLY PERFORMED BY PRIVATE CONTRACTOR  
5 AT A LOWER COST THAN IF WORK WERE PERFORMED BY CITY  
6 EMPLOYEES AT PRESENTLY BUDGETED LEVELS.

7 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco adopted a  
8 new charter effective July 1, 1996 which in Section 10.104(15) incorporates the  
9 provisions of Proposition "J" adopted November 1976, adding Section 8.300-1 to the  
10 1932 Charter, allowing City Departments to contract with private companies for specific  
11 services which can be practically performed for a lower cost than similar work by City  
12 and County employees; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on April 16, 1998, that the services  
15 involved in the management and operations of an Airport Information Booth Program at  
16 San Francisco International Airport can be practically performed by Polaris Research and  
17 Development at a lower cost to the City and County of San Francisco than if such  
18 services were performed by employees of the City and County of San Francisco; now,  
19 therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That, pursuant to Section 10.104(15) of the Charter, this Board of  
22 Supervisors hereby approves said Controller's Certification.
