

[Accept and Expend Grant - Youth Stewardship Program - \$20,000]

Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$20,000 to support the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department Youth Stewardship Program 2009-2010.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Foundation's environmental fund provides funding to non profits organizations and public agencies to promote sustainable practices and equitable development that guarantee livable communities and healthy environments; and,

WHEREAS, The Youth Stewardship Program has been engaging youth, 3rd-12th grade in habitat restoration and environmental education projects in parks city-wide for the past twelve years; and,

WHEREAS, The Youth Stewardship Program meets the objectives of the San Francisco Foundation environmental fund; and,

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Foundation's grant will be allocated to non-profit Urban Service Project for Contractual services; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not include indirect funds to maximize the use of the grant; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Commission by Resolution number **0703-007** did recommend the San Francisco Board of Supervisors to apply, accept and expend a grant in the amount of up to \$30,000 from the San Francisco Foundation for the Recreation and Park Department's Volunteer Services Division; now, therefore, be it


RESOLUTION NO.

5 costs in the grant budget; and, be it


6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors appoints the General Manager




