13	Cal or the Healthy Families Program; and,
14	WHEREAS, children eligible for federal reimbursement include documented US
15	residents and citizens up to age 19 who are between 250 and 300 percent of federal poverty;
16	and,
17	WHEREAS, Approximately 30 percent of current Healthy Kids enrollment meets those
18	criteria, and,
19	WHEREAS, San Francisco and other participating counties will be able to bill and
20	collect for children enrolled retroactively to January 1, 2003, and,
21	WHEREAS, Depending upon the availability of federal funding for California in the S-
22	CHIP program, the performance agreement may be renewed for periods beyond June 30,

1	WHEREAS, This performance agreement, for an estimated \$4,378,351 includes
2	payments covering the retroactive period to January 1, 2003 and estimated payments through
3	June 30, 2007, and,
4	WHEREAS, MRMIB and SFDPH have agreed to enter into a subcontract agreement to
5	participate in this project; and,
6	WHEREAS, MRMIB has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of up to
7	\$4,378,351 under the terms of this subcontract agreement; and,
8	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving these funds, MRMIB requires SFDPH to enter
9	into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
10	Supervisors in File No; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
11	resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,
12	WHEREAS, The terms of the subcontract agreement prohibit including indirect costs in
13	the grant budget; now, therefore, be it
14	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter into a subcontract agreement
15	in the amount of \$4,378,351 with MRMIB; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
17	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it
18	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
