3 **Resolution designating the San Francisco Chronicle and Examiner to be the official**  
4 **newspapers of the City and County of San Francisco for the category of Type 1**  
5 **consecutive day , and Type 2 non consecutive day official advertising services for the**  
6 **fiscal year commencing upon Board of Supervisors and Mayoral approval and ending**  
7 **June 30, 2006.**

9 WHEREAS, in each year, the Board of Supervisors shall designate the official  
10 newspaper of the City and County of San Francisco, pursuant to Article IX, Section 2.80-1 and  
11 2.81 of the San Francisco Administrative Code; now therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Chronicle, and Examiner are newspapers of  
13 general circulation published in the City and County of San Francisco for the dissemination of  
14 local or telegraphic news and intelligence of a general character, having a bona fide  
15 circulation of at least 50,000 copies per calendar week, printed in the City and County on  
16 three or more days in a calendar week, are hereby designated as an official newspapers of  
17 the City and County of San Francisco, commencing upon Board of Supervisors and Mayoral  
18 approval, for the publication of all official advertising of the City and County which is required  
19 by law, other than the provisions of Section 2.103 of the Charter as they relate to special  
20 meetings of the Board of Supervisors and its special or standing committees, to be published  
21 one time, and all official advertising of the City and County which is required by law to be  
22 published more than one, but not more than three times per week for a specified number of  
23 weeks, and, be it
