3 PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS'
4 CONFERENCE ROOM ONE DAY A WEEK BY OTHER CITY GOVERNMENT
5 GROUPS FOR A SEVEN MONTH PERIOD NOT TO EXTEND BEYOND
6 AUGUST 31, 2000.

8 WHEREAS, The rules for the use of the Board of
9 Supervisors' conference room are limited to an occasional
10 meeting of other city government groups, and that the Clerk
11 of the Board shall not permit regular use of the conference
12 room for other purposes without the approval of the Board of
13 Supervisors; and

14 WHEREAS, The Assessment Appeals Board III requires the
15 use of a meeting room in City Hall for the purpose of
16 hearing the One Market Plaza appeal scheduled to begin on
17 January 31, 2000, for three days a week for a period not to
18 extend beyond August 31, 2000; and

19 WHEREAS, Regular meeting Room 406 of the Assessment
20 Appeals Board is currently being fully utilized for the
21 Viacom hearing as well as other hearings; and

22 WHEREAS, The Building Maintenance Division has limited
23 meeting rooms to accommodate over 60 boards and commissions
24 which meet at City Hall; and

1 WHEREAS, The Assessment Appeals Board explored use of
2 meeting rooms outside of City Hall and was unable to locate
3 a facility that was willing to allow up to three days a week
4 for seven months, with the exception of a location at 575
5 Polk Street, which would involve an expense of approximately
6 \$680 per day; and

7 WHEREAS, The Building Maintenance Division has
8 attempted to accommodate the Assessment Appeals Board with
9 the provision that the Board of Supervisors' conference room
10 be available for one day a week for uses by other City
11 government groups during the seven month period; now,
12 therefore, be it

13 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors allows the use of
14 its conference room (Room 278) by other city government
15 groups for one day a week from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for a
16 period not to extend beyond the seven months beginning
17 January 31, 2000, and expiring August 31, 2000.
