3 **Resolution appointing Maria Guadalupe Arreola, term ending August 20, 2003, and**
4 **Maggie Davis, Michelle Horneff, and Lisa Block, terms ending August 20, 2005, to the**
5 **Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee, residency requirement**
6 **waived.**

8 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
9 does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Lead
10 Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the San
11 Francisco Health Code, Section 1607, for the term specified:

12 Maria Guadalupe Arreola (residency requirement waived), succeeding Francisco
13 Casique, resigned, seat 3, must represent a tenant organization, for the unexpired portion of a
14 four-year term ending August 20, 2003;

15 Maggie Davis (residency requirement waived), succeeding Maggie Davis-Badger, term
16 expired, seat 7, must represent the Mayor's Office of Housing and Child Care, for a new four
17 term ending August 20, 2005;

18 Michelle Horneff, succeeding herself, term expired, seat 14, must have expertise in real
19 estate, for a new four-year term ending August 20, 2005;

20 Lisa Block, succeeding Octavia Jolley, term expired, seat 15, must have expertise in
21 environmental matters, for a new a four-year term ending August 20, 2005; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 23 1. The membership of the Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee
24 has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San
25 Francisco.

- 1 2. Applicants Maria Guadalupe Arreola and Maggie Davis, new appointees, who are
2 not residents of San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies
3 him/her to serve on the Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee.
- 4 3. The Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee has attempted to fill
5 the position, for which Guadalupe Arreola and Maggie Davis were nominated, with
6 individuals who are City residents and who have the specific experience, skills, and
7 qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has
8 certified that Guadalupe Arreola and Maggie Davis are qualified to serve on the
9 Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory Committee.
- 10 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there are no
11 other possible representative, who are residents of San Francisco and who have
12 the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and
13 who are willing to serve on the Lead Poisoning Prevention Citizens Advisory
14 Committee at this time; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency
16 requirement for Guadalupe Arreola and Maggie Davis, as allowed in cases where no qualified
17 City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that
18 requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by
19 legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San
20 Francisco.




