

1 [Study of HIV transmission behavior in HIV-positive men.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to enter**
4 **retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$37,906 with the University of**
5 **California, San Francisco (UCSF), the primary contractor, to participate in a study to**
6 **examine decisions to have high transmission-risk sex; study the efficacy of a**
7 **prevention counseling intervention; and determine whether future episodes of**
8 **unprotected sex are reduced, for the period of September 1, 2006 to August 31, 2007.**

10 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institutes of
11 Health (NIH) to conduct a program titled “Changing HIV Transmission Behavior in HIV-
12 Positive Men”; and,

13 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of NIH, UCSF, and DPH to participate
14 in this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse DPH in the amount of \$37,906 under the
16 terms of this agreement; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires DPH to enter into a
18 subcontract (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
19 Supervisors in File No. 071262, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if
20 set forth fully within; and,

21 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required because this funding will be used to
22 reimburse the department for three existing positions, including two Senior Physician
23 Specialists (Job Class 2232) at .06 and .03 FTE and one Epidemiologist II (Job Class 2803) at
24 .15 FTE for the period of September 1, 2006 through August 31, 2007; and

1 WHEREAS, This agreement is an extension of a project previously initiated and
2 approved by the Board of Supervisors in Resolution Number 622-06; and,

3 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because the final
4 agreement was not obtained by DPH until August 21, 2007; and,

5 WHEREAS, The contract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$4,061; now,
6 therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
8 agreement in the amount of \$37,906 with UCSF, the primary contractor, for services under the
9 program entitled "Changing HIV Transmission Behavior in HIV-Positive Men"; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
11 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
13 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
14 the agreement expires.
