10	unique program based in San Francisco serving high risk and underserved Asian and Pacific
11	Islander families and children; and
12	WHEREAS, APIFRN is comprised of twenty-seven Asian and Pacific Islander
13	community-based organizations to provide an effective networking system for at-risk API families
14	and children; and
15	WHEREAS, The program utilizes a multi-disciplinary team approach with effective
16	bilingual and bicultural human services with a comprehensive distinctive language and
17	culture, including case management, parenting education, emotional support, counseling,
18	crisis intervention, health services, and assistance with agency referrals; and
19	WHEREAS, In San Francisco, the Asian and Pacific Islander population continues to
20	grow with multiple needs, and home to the highest concentration of Asian and Pacific Islander
21	residents of any large city in northern California; and
22	WHEREAS, APIFRN continues to provide an invaluable contribution of human services
23	and reflect a program devoted to the highest ideals of community service; now, therefore, be it
