

1 [Liquor License - 50 Mason Street]

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3 **Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general public**  
4 **premises license to Pandora Karaoke, Inc. dba Pandora Karaoke, located at 50**  
5 **Mason (District 6), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and**  
6 **County of San Francisco in accordance with California Business and Professions**  
7 **Code, Section 23958.4, and recommending that the California Department of**  
8 **Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.**

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10 WHEREAS, Pandora Karaoke, Inc. is seeking the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale  
11 general public premises license dba Pandora Karaoke, located at 50 Mason Street  
12 (District 6); and

13 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly  
14 zoned and recommends approval; and

15 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed zero (0) protests with the  
16 Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business and Professions  
17 Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage  
18 Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

19 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department, as  
20 amended, are the following: 1) sales, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages  
21 shall be permitted form 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight, Sunday through Wednesday, and  
22 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., Thursday through Saturday; 2) the sale of alcoholic beverages  
23 for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited; 3) Karaoke Studio Room  
24 constructed on the premises shall have the following characteristics:

25 a) A viewing window in the door or wall;

1           b) The view through the windows shall not be constructed in any way nor shall  
2           any physical obstruction including but not limited to planters, partitions, or items  
3           of décor, be placed in front of or behind or attached to any section of the door or  
4           windows;  
5           c) All doors to said studio rooms will remain unlocked and shall not have any  
6           form of locking mechanism attached at or near the doors;  
7           d) The “Studio Rooms” shall be equipped with audio and video equipment  
8           sufficient for performances commonly associated with “karaoke” style  
9           entertainment;  
10          e) Karaoke entertainment must be available at all times in the rooms during the  
11          hours of operation of the premises;  
12          4) petitioner(s) shall make no changes in the premises interior without prior written  
13          approval from the department; 5) no employee or agent shall be permitted to accept  
14          money or any other thing of value from customer for the purpose of sitting or otherwise  
15          spending time with customers while in the premises, nor shall the licensee provide or  
16          permit, or make available either gratuitous or for compensation, male or female persons  
17          who act as escorts, companions, or guests of and for the customers; 6) no employee or  
18          agent shall solicit or accept any alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverage from any customer  
19          while in the premises; 7) loitering (is defined as “to stand idly about; linger aimlessly  
20          without lawful business”) is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the  
21          licensed premises under the control of the licensee as depicted on the ABC-257 dated  
22          1/27/2016; 8) no noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the  
23          licensee(s) as depicted on the ABC-257 dated 1-27-2016; 9) the petitioner(s) shall  
24          utilize electronic surveillance and recording equipment that is able to view inside and  
25          outside of the premises and that is actively maintained and recorded. This electronic

1 surveillance shall be in place during operating hours. Said electronic recording shall be  
2 kept up to (72) hours and shall be made available to the Department or police  
3 department upon demand; 10) at no time shall a customer have direct access, self-  
4 service access to alcoholic beverages. All sales and service of alcoholic beverages  
5 shall go through an employee of the premises to the customer; 11) the petitioner(s) shall  
6 be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which  
7 they have control; 12) graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots  
8 under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a  
9 Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72  
10 hours of the beginning of the next weekday; and 13) the licensee(s) or employee of the  
11 licensee will monitor the interior of the premises at all times that alcoholic beverages are  
12 being served or consumed, to ensure that the premises will operate in compliance with  
13 all applicable laws and/ or conditions; now, therefore, be it

14           RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,  
15 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
16 hereby determines that the issuance of a Type 48 on-sale general public premises  
17 license to Pandora Karaoke, Inc., dba Pandora Karaoke, located at 50 Mason Street  
18 (District 6), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and County of San  
19 Francisco; and, be it

20           FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of  
21 San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police  
22 Department listed above, and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage  
23 Control issue the license with those conditions.

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
