

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Increasing Compensation - Assessment Appeals Board Members]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to increase compensation received by members of the Assessment Appeals Board to \$125 for each hearing, or for each morning or afternoon of a hearing, not to exceed \$375 per day; except, when sitting individually as an assessment hearing officer, members receive \$125 for each morning or afternoon of service, not to exceed \$250 per day.

Existing Law

Members of the Assessment Appeals Boards receive \$100 for each half-day of service on any Board. Members serving as assessment hearing officers receive the same compensation.

Amendments to Current Law

For members serving on a Board panel, compensation would increase to \$125 for each hearing on which the member serves, if confined to a morning or afternoon; and if continued, \$125 for each morning or each afternoon of the continued hearing. "Hearing" means the Board or a panel of the Board convening to consider the matter or matters that appear on a single meeting agenda.

For members serving as assessment hearing officers, compensation would increase to \$125 for each morning or afternoon of service.

For members serving in either capacity, compensation would be limited to a maximum of \$375 for each calendar day.
