WHEREAS, The FY2018 Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) provides grant funding to port areas for the protection of critical port infrastructure from terrorism; and

WHEREAS, On June 18, 2018, the Port of San Francisco applied for grant funds under the FY2018 PSGP; and

WHEREAS, On September 14, 2018, the Port was awarded \$105,000 in grant funds for the buildout of an alternative DOC at Pier 50 to back up the Port's primary DOC at Pier 1; and

WHEREAS, On April 4, 2019, through Resolution No. 19-10, the Port Commission authorized the Executive Director to seek the Board of Supervisors' approval to accept and expend the grant, including any extensions, augmentations or amendments thereof; and

WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions and will not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Port funds (\$35,000) have been identified to provide the required 25% of the total project cost of \$140,000 in required non-federal match monies; and

WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Port of San Francisco to accept and expend \$105,000 in grant funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for security improvements at the Port of San Francisco; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Port, subject to the Board of Supervisors' approval, authorizes the Executive Director or her designee to execute for and on behalf of the City and County, any documents necessary to enter into the grant agreement with the Federal Emergency Management Agency within the Department of Homeland Security, including any extensions, augmentations or amendments, thereof.
