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- 3 Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to
- 4 retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$97,660 from the Social
- 5 Security Administration (SSA) to provide SSI application assistance to the chronically
- 6 homeless and mentally ill in San Francisco and to enter into an agreement for the use
- of these funds; for the period of May 1, 2007 to April 30, 2008, which includes a sub-
- 8 contract with the San Francisco Bar Association's Homeless Advocacy Project (HAP)
- 9 in the amount of \$59,620 for the same time period.

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- WHEREAS, DPH was awarded an extension to a grant from SSA in the amount of \$97,660 to provide SSI application assistance to the chronically homeless and mentally ill in San Francisco; and,
- WHEREAS, Originally this grant was to fund a three-year project, with FY 2006-07 as the final year, however SSA extended the project for an additional year; and,
 - WHEREAS, Funding supports inter-agency linkages among DPH, the Human Services Agency (HSA), and HAP, allowing for better outreach and service in extending SSI application assistance to a very hard to reach transient population; and,
 - WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SSA requires the City to comply with the terms of an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 071130, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,
 - WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses DPH for one existing position, Medical Records Clerk (Job Class 2110), at .5 FTE, for the period of May 1, 2007 through April 30, 2008; and,

1	WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on	
2	program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it	
3	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a	
4	grant in the amount of \$97,660 from SSA; and, be it	
5	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of	
6	indirect costs in the grant budget, and, be it	
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and	
8	expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement,	
9	pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.170-1; and, be it	
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the	
11	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it	
12	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded	
13	under this agreement a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the	
14	agreement expires.
