6 1984 and has had 16 years of uninterrupted service to the citizens of our City; and,

7 WHEREAS, Captain Manheimer was recently selected to become the Chief of
8 Police for the City of San Mateo; and,

9 WHEREAS, in her years of service she held various positions in the San
10 Francisco Police Department, including but not limited to Patrol Officer at both the
11 Ingleside and Mission Stations, Undercover Officer assigned to major long term sting
12 operations, Sargeant-Inspector in the Investigations Bureau, Member of the Tactical
13 Investigations Unit, Platoon Commander to the Taravel Station and finally Commanding
14 Officer of the Tenderloin Task Force; and,

15 WHEREAS, Captain Manheimer has always pro-actively requested and sought
16 out the most difficult challenges in the department, some of which were life threatening,
17 including her work focusing on gang abatement, dignitary protection and working as a
18 robbery decoy; and,

19 WHEREAS, Captain Manheimer requested to serve on the Tenderloin Task
20 Force, among the most difficult assignments in the City, out of her love of community
21 and her dedication to serve the most marginalized of our residents; and

22 WHEREAS, Captain Manheimer was among the earliest proponents of the
23 principles of community policing putting those principles into practice with outstanding
24 results and thereby proving their worth and value for the entire department; be it,

Manheimer, Badge #611, for her tireless, energetic and passionate leadership in serving
all of San Francisco's residents with dignity and integrity and wishes her the very best in




