

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant - Sheriff's Department program providing employment
2 and education services for young offenders in the county jail and after their release.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to accept and expend a year III**
4 **continuation grant (Year III) in the amount of \$76,283 from the Private Industry**
5 **Council of San Francisco for providing employment and education services to**
6 **young offenders in the county jail and after their release, and waiving indirect**
7 **costs.**

8 WHEREAS, The Private Industry Council of San Francisco has made available
9 funding through the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Title 1B youth programs; and,

10 WHEREAS, Due to the need for education and job development among young
11 offenders, the Sheriff's Department will provide a program to support academic,
12 vocational, and personal development for young offenders while in custody and after
13 their release from custody; and,

14 WHEREAS, The grant does not require matching funds; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department proposes to maximize use of available
16 grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant
17 budget; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect
19 costs in the grant budget; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the grant award notification has been received
21 from the Private Industry Council of San Francisco; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the grant provides for the support of a part-time
23 position as follows: 0.05 FTE Senior Administrative Analyst at a salary of \$3,486 bi-
24 weekly plus benefits; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
2 of San Francisco authorizes the Sheriff's Department to accept and expend \$76,283
3 in grant funds from the Private Industry Council of San Francisco; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will adhere
5 to the requirements of the Private Industry Council of San Francisco and all conditions
6 specified in the grant agreement.
