URGING THE SAN FRANCISCO HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION TO CONDUCT HEARINGS AND GATHER TESTIMONY AND OTHER EVIDENCE TO EXPLORE AMENDING THE SAN FRANCISCO ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO ENSURE FULL AND EQUITABLE OPPORTUNITIES FOR UTILIZATION OF DISABLED PERSON BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AND DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AND TO CORRECT IDENTIFIED DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICES INHERENT IN THE CITY'S PROCUREMENT PROCESS AND IN THE AWARD OF PRIME CONTRACTS TO DISABLED PERSON BUSINESS ENTERPRISES AND DISABLED VETERAN BUSINESS ENTERPRISES.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Human Rights Commission works to provide leadership and advocacy to secure, protect and promote human rights for all people; and,

WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission is responsible for implementing San Francisco's Minority/Woman/Local Business Enterprise Ordinance, located in Administrative Code Chapter 12; and,

WHEREAS, The Minority/Woman/Local Business Enterprise Ordinance, located in Administrative Code Chapter 12, promotes the use of minority business enterprises and women business enterprises as prime and sub contractors on City and Country contracts; and,

WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission investigates and mediates discrimination complaints, including complaints and mediation involving persons with disabilities and veterans with disabilities, and provides referrals to other government agencies as appropriate; and.

WHEREAS, Disabled individuals have filed complaints of discrimination with the Human Rights Commission; and,

WHEREAS, Disabled individuals and organizations advocating for the civil rights and fair treatment of disabled individuals have expressed a need to include disabled person business enterprises and disabled veteran business enterprises in the Administrative Code in order to correct identified discriminatory practices inherent in the City's procurement process and in the award of prime contracts to disabled person business enterprises and disabled veteran business enterprises; and,

WHEREAS, In order to substantiate the need for amending the Administrative Code, general findings will need to be made which demonstrate discriminatory practices inherent in the City's procurement process and in the award of prime contracts to disabled person business enterprises and disabled veteran business enterprises; and,

WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission is the appropriate department to conduct hearings and gather testimony regarding possible discriminatory practices inherent in the City's procurement process and in the award of prime contracts to disabled person business enterprises and disabled veteran business enterprises in order to develop the findings necessary for amending the Administrative Code; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco Human Rights Commission to conduct hearings and gather testimony and other evidence to explore amending the San Francisco Administrative Code to ensure full and equitable opportunities for utilization of disabled person business enterprises and disabled veteran business enterprises in order to correct identified discriminatory practices inherent in the city's procurement process and in the award of prime contracts to disabled person business enterprises and disabled veteran business enterprises.
