3 **Resolution declaring July 16, 2024, as Julie Van Nostern Day in the City and County of**  
4 **San Francisco, in recognition of her many years of outstanding service in the City**  
5 **Attorney’s Office and her well-deserved retirement.**

7 WHEREAS, Julie Van Nostern joined the City Attorney’s Office nearly 40 years ago,  
8 beginning a storied career as a committed advocate and advisor for scores of City  
9 departments, commissions, Supervisors, and eight Mayors; and

10 WHEREAS, During her tenure as a Deputy under four City Attorneys, Julie worked as a  
11 litigator and a general counsel on seven teams in that Office, including as the head of the City  
12 Attorney’s Port, Tax, and Health & Human Services Teams; and

13 WHEREAS, Julie’s list of accomplishments is long, and her impact on the City cannot  
14 be overstated: among other projects, she represented the Port in the Giant’s ballpark project  
15 and plans for its waterfront; she led a team that saved the City hundreds of millions of dollars  
16 after an appellate court decision left the City facing close to \$800 million in tax liability; and  
17 she played a lead role in preserving Laguna Honda Hospital and Rehabilitation Center in 2021  
18 after the federal government unexpectedly revoked its certification; and

19 WHEREAS, Beginning in January 2020, Julie worked tirelessly—and fiercely—for two  
20 years during the COVID-19 pandemic, overseeing the City Attorney’s advice to the  
21 Department of Public Health and other departments to help keep the residents of the City  
22 safe; and

23 WHEREAS, Through all those crises and challenges, Julie has appeared before this  
24 Board and met with Supervisors privately many times to provide guidance and caution; and

1           WHEREAS, Julie is a talented attorney, a devoted and loyal colleague and friend to her  
2 coworkers in the City Attorney’s Office, and a self-sacrificing public servant who has given so  
3 much to this City; and

4           WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors and the City are immeasurably better for Julie’s  
5 service; and

6           WHEREAS, Julie’s service to the City ended on June 30, 2024, with her retirement,  
7 which, though richly deserved, will be lamented by this Board and the many others in City  
8 government she has so faithfully served; now, therefore, be it

9           RESOLVED, That in celebration of Julie’s outstanding accomplishments and  
10 contributions to the City and County of San Francisco, the Board of Supervisors does hereby  
11 declare July 16, 2024, to be Julie Van Nostern Day in San Francisco.
