2 URGING THE RECREATION AND PARKS DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT A COST
3 ANALYSIS FOR THE RENOVATION OF THE SUNNYSIDE CONSERVATORY AND TO
4 ALLOCATE FUNDING IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2000-2001 BUDGET FOR REGULAR
5 GARDENING AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY.

7 WHEREAS, The Sunnyside Conservatory, an architectural treasure of San Francisco's
8 history for over a century and a designated landmark, has for decades been left in a state of
9 disrepair with missing windows, lack of proper fencing for protection from vandals, and a
10 damaged structure that prevents basic use of the facility; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Sunnyside Conservatory, one of San Francisco's most important
12 botanical collections, houses hundreds of unique and exotic plants that have been cared for
13 primarily by volunteers and are in danger of dying unless they receive additional care; and,

14 WHEREAS, If restored and cared for properly, the Sunnyside Conservatory would be
15 an important resource for San Francisco's school children to study ecology and history, and
16 furthermore, the conservatory would be used for weddings, chamber music, and would add to
17 the many sites that travelers to San Francisco would want to visit; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Sunnyside Conservatory, like so many of San Francisco's
19 architectural and historical treasures will be lost to our City if we do not take action to restore,
20 protect and maintain it; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
22 urges the Recreation and Park Department to perform an analysis of the cost to renovate and
23 maintain the Sunnyside Conservatory; and, be it


