

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO REPLACE THE  
3 STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE SEWER ON 4<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE FROM GEARY BOULEVARD TO  
4 BALBOA STREET.

5 WHEREAS, On March 27, 1998, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency condition on 4<sup>th</sup>  
6 Avenue from Geary Boulevard to Balboa Street; and,

7 WHEREAS, The existing sewer had collapsed, and immediate repairs were required in order to  
8 protect the health, welfare, and property of the Citizens of San Francisco; and,

9 WHEREAS, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specification for Contract No.  
10 CW-182E, "4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Emergency Sewer Replacement" to replace the existing 8-inch, 21-inch, and 24-  
11 inch diameter sewers with 652 linear feet of 12-inch, 52 linear feet of 24-inch, and 639 linear feet of 30-  
12 inch diameter vitrified clay pipe (VCP) sewers on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Geary Boulevard to Balboa Street; and,

13 WHEREAS, The Contractor, Vargas & Esquivel/K.J. Woods, began the emergency work on April  
14 15, 1998 and completed it on June 5, 1998; and,

15 WHEREAS, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not  
16 established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water Repair and  
17 Replacement Program; and,

18 WHEREAS, The cost of the project is estimated to be \$431,120.00, of which \$366,470.00 is for the  
19 construction contract. Funds are available from the Repair & Replacement Fund (Fund 5C/CPF/R&R,  
20 FAMIS Project No. CENRNR969, Job Order No. 1599N); and,

21 WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30 of  
22 the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an emergency;  
23 now, therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the

1 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate sewer on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Geary Boulevard to  
2 Balboa Street.
