[Resolution Urging Establishment of a Federal Prescription Drug Benefit Program]

Resolution urging Congress to pass legislation establishing a Prescription Drug Benefit Program that incorporates the principles outlined by the San Francisco Office on the Aging.

WHEREAS, Prescription drug benefits is a national issue requiring the combined effort of all levels of government; and,

WHEREAS, There are several legislative proposals for a prescription drug benefit program before the 107th Congress; and,

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Office on the Aging, supported by the National Association of Area Agencies on Aging, urges the 107th Congress to incorporate the following principles concerning Medicare and prescription drug benefits; and,

WHEREAS, According to the San Francisco Office on the Aging, a national Prescription Drug Benefit Program should:

- a) Guarantee comprehensive coverage of prescription drugs while maintaining access to other Medicare benefits:
- b) Provide prescription drugs regardless of income or health status;
- c) Provide safeguards against erosion of drug coverage from other sources;
- d) Create a consumer-driven environment that includes appropriate cost-containment measures;
- e) Prevent the misuse of prescription and over-the-counter drugs through various educational programs and efforts; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges Congress to pass legislation establishing a Prescription Drug Benefit Program that will incorporate such principles as

outlined by the San Francisco Office on the Aging and supported by the National Association of Area Agencies on Aging.
