WHEREAS, the CEC requires that the City shall indemnify, defend, and save harmless the state, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to recipient and to any and all contractors, subcontractors, materialmen, laborers, and any other person, firm, or corporation furnishing or supplying work, services, materials, or supplies in connection with the performance of this agreement, and from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to any person, firm, or corporation who may be injured or damaged by the recipient in the performance of this agreement; now, therefore be it

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RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Administrative Services to accept and expend \$90,000 from the California Energy Commission, waiving indirect costs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of Administrative Services to enter into an agreement with the California Energy Commission for the purpose of receiving this grant award, which agreement may provide for the City to indemnify, defend, and save harmless the state, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to recipient and to any and all contractors, subcontractors, materialmen, laborers, and any other person, firm, or corporation furnishing or supplying work, services, materials, or supplies in connection with the performance of this agreement, and from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to any person, firm, or corporation who may be injured or damaged by the recipient in the performance of this agreement.
