WHEREAS, The Omnibus Appropriations Act of 1996 establishes the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program (LLEBG) under authority of the U.S. Department of Justice; and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Justice Assistance issued a Notice of Fund Availability on June 12, 1998 for the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program to support local efforts to reduce crime and increase public safety; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco can utilize Local Law Enforcement Block Grant funds for four Federal purpose areas; purchasing equipment and supporting overtime for law enforcement officers, community crime prevention, the expansion and development of Drug Courts, and the enhancement of adjudication for violent offenders, and

WHEREAS, To be eligible for LLEBG funds, the City and County San Francisco convened the Mayor's Criminal Justice Council, an advisory body of local law enforcement and court officials representatives from the School District, Department of

WHEREAS, To be eligible for LLEBG funds, that prior to the obligations of funds, San Francisco held a public hearing regarding the proposed use of LLEBG funds at the Board of Supervisors Finance Committee meeting, and






Department of Justice to support local efforts to reduce crime and increase public safety; and be it


