	OR PNEUMONIA – APPLICATION TO MEMBERS WITH FIVE OR MORE YEARS OF
14	SERVICE. The provisions of the preceding section shall apply only to members of the Police and Fire
15	Departments, respectively, who shall have served <u>a total of</u> five or more years:
16 17	(a) in one or both of such departments; or,
18	(b) as a San Francisco Airport police officer; or,
19	(c) in another police of fire department in the State of California, provided that the member
20	was entitled to the same presumption in his or her prior employment, and provided that the member
21	became a member of the San Francisco Police or Fire Department within six months of separating
22	from such prior employment.
23	The provisions of subsections (b) and (c) of this section shall apply only to injuries or deaths
24	occurring after January 1, 2000, and only to applications for benefits under the San Francisco City and
	County Employees' Retirement System.
