

1 [Proposition J Contract / Laundry Services At San Francisco General Hospital.]

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3 **Resolution concurring with the Controller’s certification that the laundry services can**
4 **be performed for the Department of Public Health, San Francisco General Hospital by**
5 **private contractor for a lower cost than similar work performed by City and County**
6 **employees.**

8 WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco passed
9 Proposition J in November 1976, allowing City Departments to contract with private
10 companies for specific services which can be performed for a lower cost than similar work by
11 City and County employees (Charter Section 10.104.15); and,

12 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Health, San Francisco General Hospital, will
13 access a Purchaser’s awarded contract for these Laundry Services; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Controller’s certification of May 9, 2003, confirms that said services
15 can be performed at lower costs to the City and County by private contractor than by
16 employees of the City and County on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in
17 File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully
18 herein; now, therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby concurs with the Controller’s
20 certification and approves the Proposition J Resolution for the period July 1, 2003 through
21 ~~June~~ March 30, 2004.
