
### Key New Features


- Store relevant permit application forms, Starter Kits, and additional resources



### Next Steps - Phase III


### **Enhancements**

- Develop Web-forms & back end permit application workflows
- Integrate permit forms with Digital/Electronic Signature provider (DocuSign)
- Implement Electronic Payment functionality for license/permit fees (FIS)
- Allow data pre-fill to auto-populate directly from user-profile

### **Ongoing Maintenance**

- Continue improving user-experience through testing & iterative design
- Update content as legislation and needs change, especially permits and starter kits
- Create new content (Starter Kits, TTX New Biz Registration, Gross Receipts Tax, etc.)
- Regularly audit/update links and permit forms
- Install Drupal security updates as necessary
- Maintain & plan to operationalize at OSB in FY17-18
